

# Directions to Dundee

---

**St Paul's Cathedral is located in the heart of Dundee City Centre, within walking distance of Dundee Railway and Bus Stations.**

**Rail** - Dundee is on the main East Coast route with direct services to Newcastle, York and London, and to Carlisle, Preston, Coventry, Birmingham, Oxford, Bristol, Reading, Southampton, Bournemouth and Plymouth. There are overnight sleeper services from London, the south coast and the West Country. Rail journeys to the other major cities in Scotland (Aberdeen, Edinburgh and Glasgow) take approximately 1 1/4hrs, and the regular service from London King's Cross takes only six hours. On your arrival, turn left at the station entrance, cross over South Marketgait and walk up Union Street to Nethergate. Turn right and you will see the Cathedral spire to your right, past Caird Hall/City Square (see map below).

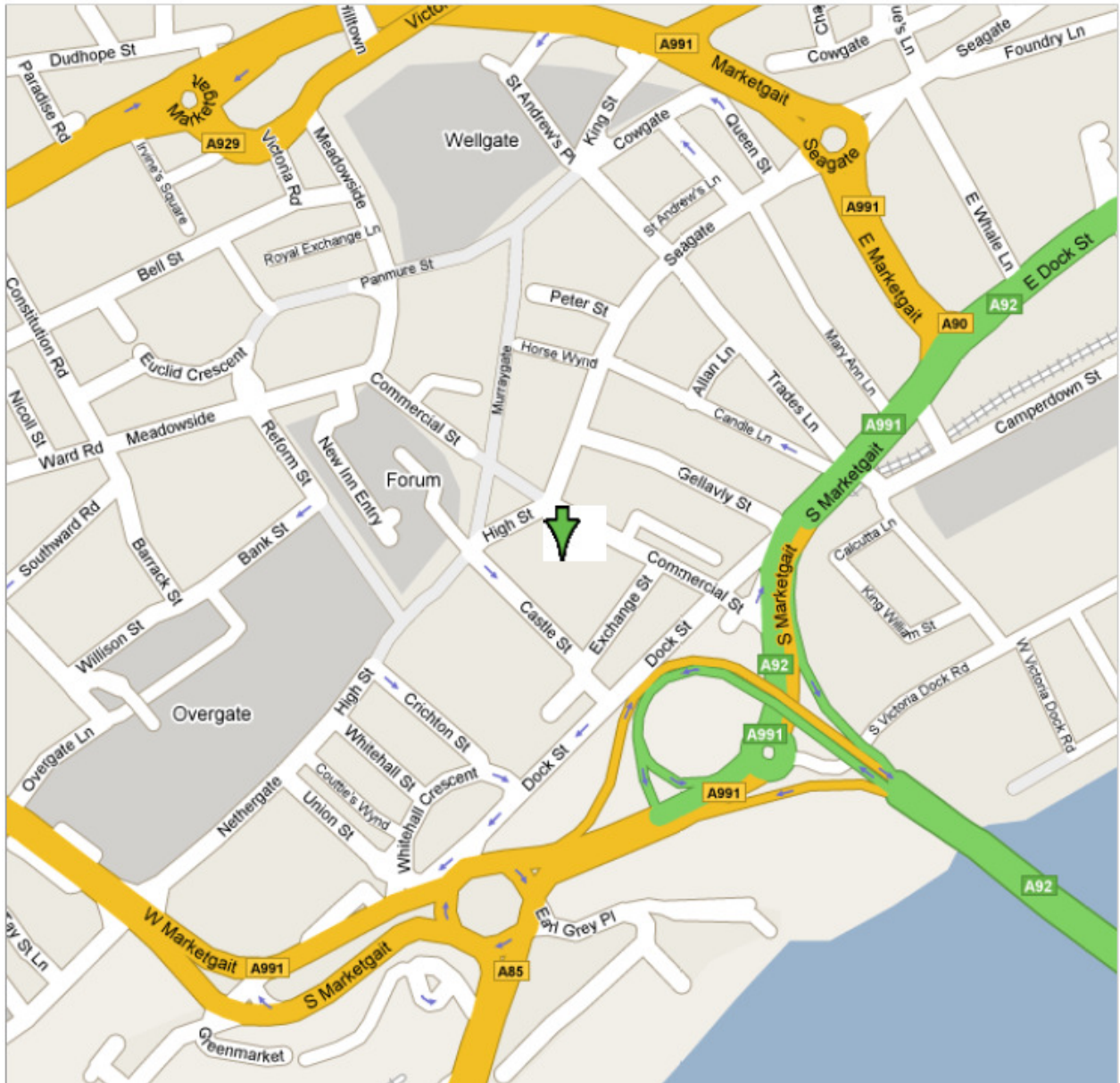
**Coach** - Day and night coach services (operated by National Express, Stagecoach Group, and Scottish Citylink) are available from/to major cities throughout the UK including London. Dundee's main bus station is on Seagate, approximately 2 minutes walk from the Cathedral. Exit the station to Seagate, turn left, and you will see the Cathedral immediately in front of you.

**Air** - ScotAirways operate from London City airport to Dundee airport, located near the city centre. You will need to take a short taxi ride into the city centre.

**Car** - If travelling by car, Dundee is on the M90/A90 route which travels up the east coast of Scotland.

- When entering from the south, take the 3<sup>rd</sup> exit at the first roundabout at the city boundary (A85, Riverside Avenue) and head towards the city centre. You will pass through three more roundabouts
- Next is a major roundabout: keep to the middle lane, taking the 2<sup>nd</sup> exit (passing under the Tay Road Bridge approaches) labelled "Aberdeen A991/A92". **MAKE SURE YOU DON'T GO INTO THE FAR LEFT LANE OR YOU WILL GO ONTO THE TAY ROAD BRIDGE.**
- You will come to a smaller roundabout, take the 1<sup>st</sup> exit (A991/A92 to Aberdeen, South Marketgait), and then immediately turn left into Commercial Street.
- On your left is a small pay and display car park, or you can take the first turn on your right and follow the road to a secure pay and display multi-storey car park in Gellavly Street.

- The Cathedral is located at the corner of High Street, Commercial Street and Seagate - look for the tall spire.
